First initiation in UK

On December 7th 2018, the first initiation within our UK network took place. This initiation was held in the Royal Berkshire Hospital in Reading. The ICNARC and Imperial teams worked with the project managers from UMC Utrecht, and the visit was very successful. We are looking forward to collaborating with the Royal Berkshire and other UK hospitals. More sites in the United Kingdom will be initiated early this year.

Approval Portugal

We are happy to announce that, after more than half a year of intensive work and communication with the Portuguese authorities, REMAP-CAP is officially approved to start recruitment in Portugal. The Centro Hospitalar do Médio Tejo in Abrantes has already included 3 patients in the trial since the Green Light letter. A monitor visit will be planned shortly. The Sponsor team from UMC Utrecht will continue searching for additional sites in Portugal.

Three patients included in Córdoba

The first site in Spain (Reina Sofia University Hospital, Córdoba) has included three patients in the last three months of 2018. Congratulations to the team for their work. According to the Monitoring Plan, a Monitoring Visit took place after three inclusions and was held in January.

REMAP-CAP inclusions on the rise

As of today, 20 patients have been included in REMAP-CAP in the EU region. A great achievement, and we hope to really "take off" during the first months of 2019. We would like to thank our great subnetworks in Germany and the UK, and our fabulous sites, for their hard work so far. Hopefully we will get many patients enrolled, we will keep you updated on our progress.
